



GARDENS, MUSIC AND ART, INSPIRATION

GARDEN 1 UPHAMS 2705 N. SHOWCASE CT., EAGLE

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From the intersection of Hwy 55/Horseshoe Bend Rd. and Beacon Light Rd, turn left on Beacon Light, go just one block, turning left at the Cheuron Station onto N. Horseshoe Bend Rd. Parking is on Deer Point Rd. near Showcase Ct.

The Upham's home near Hwy. 55 and Beacon Light features a sunken formal perennial garden and a collection of container gardens enclosing the pool area. A majestic, life size topiary, in the shape of elk, guards the meadow and stream. Extensive raised vegetable growing beds keep the family in fresh produce for the entire growing season.

GARDEN 2 SOUTHERLANDS 2729 HAVEN DRIVE, EAGLE

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Beacon Light Rd. and Ballantyne Lane, continue on Ballantyne. At Homer Rd. turn left, at Haven Dr. turn left.

The Southerlands' home off of Homer and Linder, is a cool oasis of ponds, patios, vegetable gardens, stable, barn and a loosely structured garden. Wendy Southerland, a longtime designer and employee with Edwards Greenhouses, has a passion for gardening. Her talents for re-purposing found objects is matched only by her obsession with color and plants.

GARDEN 3 CAMPS 2190 WEST BURNS ST., EAGLE

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Beacon Light, continue towards Floating Feather on Ballantyne, turning right on Burns. No exit on Burns, return to Ballantyne Ln.

Jay and Carolyn Camp's home on Burns Street near Ballantyne and Floating Feather can best be described as abundant. It begins with a cottage garden in front, bursting with perennials and something in bloom all season. Check out their new cottage business: 6000 blueberry plants.

GARDEN 4 DENNARDS 7020 N. PENNCROSS WAY, MERIDIAN

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Ballantyne turn right onto State Street/Hwy 44. (The Blue Door Café is on State St., use coupon for lunch). Turn left onto Linder Rd. Turn right on Chinden Blvd./Hwy20/26, turn right into Spur Wing Country Club at N. Spur Wing Way and right on Penncross Way. No exit on Penncross, turn around to exit Spur Wing.

The quiet formality of the Dennards' front garden gives no hint at all of the action behind the berm. Peek behind and you will discover a true urban farmstead - fruit trees, vegetables, a very tidy composting system, and bee boxes. Boxwood hedges and a tree lined swale add to the lushness of the plantings.

GARDEN 5 CARNAHANS 4410 CHINDEN BLVD., MERIDIAN

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Spur Wing Way turn right on Chinden/Hwy 44 to Garden Tour signs just before Jayker's Nursery, turning right into driveway at 4410 Chinden. Parking at end of long driveway.

The Carnahan's beautiful landscape is befitting a botanical garden in itself - from the huge stone entry to the home, with crafted iron water features that carry the stream to two separate ponds (with pedal boats and dock), a children's play area complete with tree house, swings and running paths. Stroll the allee to the disappearing edge, and the design seems endless - all framed by the Boise foothills.

THE CANAL STROLL GARDENS 6-8

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Ten Mile Rd. and Chinden/Hwy 20/26, one block before Cherry Lane, turn right on Woodmont Dr. Enter Canal Stroll at 3565 Woodmont Dr.

A short stroll along the canal by Cherry Lane Golf Course showcases three adjoining gardens. There are vivid plant collections, floriferous container gardens, vegetables and roses - each garden distinct in its own style and manner.

GARDEN 9 SMITH 869 E. ANTILLES CT., MERIDIAN

PLEASE NOTE: THE 10 MILE OVERPASS IS CLOSED

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Ten Mile Rd. turn left onto Cherry Lane. to Meridian Rd., turn right on Meridian Rd., cross over the freeway and turn left on Overland Rd. Turn right into Meridian Greens at SE 5th Way. At E. Kingsford Dr., turn left to E. St. Martin Dr., turn left to E. Antilles Ct.

The Smith's home, celebrating the Victorian style of long ago, is ornamented with pretty woodwork details and a welcoming wraparound porch. A knot garden and picket fence, dollhouse and collection of charming miniature gardens complete this picturesque setting.

GARDEN 10 GRIDLEYS 1043 E. CAYMAN DR., MERIDIAN

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Antilles Ct. and E. St. Martin Dr., turn left onto E. Cayman Dr.

The Gridley's is a low maintenance garden boasting a unique conifer collection, punches of annual color and a collection of metal art placed throughout the garden. They've created three distinct areas for entertaining: a lawn for the kids, a pool for everyone, and an outdoor "family room" complete with a water feature, fire pit, kitchen, dining space and bar.
